OP 332 - Student Dress Code

Policy

Acceptable standards for student dress and grooming will be established and maintained in the schools.

Procedures

1. Each school will establish guidelines and regulations on student attire, which will be equitable, enforceable and consistent with common sense and have the general support of the community.
2. Students must meet the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations of Alberta Labour for vocational, industrial education and other similar classes in regard to general conduct and prevention regulations related to:
 - 2.1 Protective headgear,
 - 2.2 Eye protection,
 - 2.3 Footwear,
 - 2.4 Clothing,
 - 2.5 Head and facial hair,
 - 2.6 Dangling neckwear and jewelry, and
 - 2.7 Hand protection.
3. The principal may require a student who does not meet the acceptable standards of dress and grooming to return home and change before being readmitted to class.
