

Administrative Procedure 305

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS

Background

School attendance boundaries will be established in order to provide for the efficient operation of the District by maintaining class sizes and encouraging the efficient and effective use of school buildings and transportation services.

Procedures

1. Once established, school attendance boundaries will remain in effect from year to year, unless changes in demographics or program requirements necessitate a change.
2. Changes in school attendance boundaries shall become effective prior to September 30 in any school year.
3. Students will attend classes in the schools that are within their designated attendance area.
4. Parents may choose to enroll their child in another school outside their designated attendance area if there is sufficient space and an adequate program. Parents will be responsible for the provision of any necessary transportation.
5. Should a change occur in the student's residence prior to September 30, the student will transfer to the school within the attendance boundary designated for that area.
6. Should a change occur in the student's residence after September 30, the parents, with the approval of the Principal, may choose to have the student remain in attendance at the school. However, parents will be responsible for the provision of any necessary transportation.
7. The Superintendent may approve a student's attendance at any school in the District if it appears to be in the best interests of the student and/or the school.
